

Admission

Admission is open for L.K.G. & XI Std. only. For other classes, limited vacancies, caused by transfers are filled up on the basis of merit.

Age requirement for admission

4 years as on 1st June of the year of admission of L.K.G.
and accordingly for the higher classes is essential.

Medium of Instruction

English is the medium of instruction. Tamil and Hindi are taught as languages. Tamil/Hindi/French is offered as II language for the Higher Secondary stream.

Pre School: LKG & UKG

Children are engaged actively in a set of standardized learning experiences. Through purposeful play, creativity is triggered and the outcome is happy learning. Teachers as facilitators seek to know more about the children by observing, listening, questioning and playing with them. The children feel respected and valued and believe that they are capable of higher learning. Music, dance, hands-on activities and sand play make schooling an enjoyable venture. Maths manipulatives, pattern blocks and linker cubes make real play time. 'Show and tell' helps children to enrich their confidence and vocabulary, phonemic awareness and phonics.

X by highly competent staff and the school prepares the students for the Tenth Board Exam of Tamil Nadu.






Higher Secondary School: Std. XI & XII


The State board syllabus in +1 and +2 is taught by experienced teachers to equip the students to score high marks to enter into good professional colleges on merit.

• French, Hindi & Tamil are offered as First Languages.








Library

Language Development, Maths and Science Activity Classes


Every Saturday, children are taken on an off-academic learning spree where they experience the nuances of language, science and maths through games, puzzles and activities.

Students with an outstanding record in academics and games are awarded prizes and certificates on the annual day followed by a graduation ceremony for the Board Exam going children.





















Pre-Kindergarten (with activity based classes for children between 2 and 3 years)



Geethanjali Charity Foundation also has Krish Garden School, a pre-kindergarten play school in its campus.


